

Controversies: Akzo Nobel

- Between 2010 and 2019, [Akzo Nobel and its subsidiaries paid 18,200 USD in penalties for one environmental violation](#) according to the violation tracker project of Good Jobs First.
- In 2015, [a former Akzo Nobel site in New York was put under review](#) to clean up cancer-causing pollution. Akzo Nobel used the site from 1938 to the late 2000s for the manufacture of chemicals and, according to the State Department of Environmental Conservation, the amount of PCE and PCB in found in the ground exceeds restricted residential standards.
