

## Controversies: Air Products and Chemicals, Inc.

- On 1 June 2019, there was a [hydrogen gas explosion and fire](#) at Air Products' plant in Santa Clara, California. [No one was injured and the area had been evacuated.](#)
- On 2 November 2018, an Air Products high-pressure hydrogen gas cylinder caught on fire during transportation, according to the preliminary report.
- Additionally, Air Products and its subsidiaries have paid close to [556,000 USD in environmental penalties](#) over the past ten years, according to the violation tracker project of Good Jobs First.
