Controversies: Teijin

- In December 2022, a fire occurred in Teijin's Dutch plant in Arnhem, which seriously impacted the production of aramid for the company.
- In July 2020, a <u>minor fire at the Matsuyama plant</u> because of alcohol leakage. No casualties were reported.
- In February of 2019, soil contamination was found at the Anpachigun plant in Gifu. The levels of hexavalent chromium, lead, arsenic, fluorine, and boron all exceeded the environmental standards.
- Between 2018 and 2022, Teijin paid 5,000 USD in fines for environmental violations, according to the violation tracker project of Good Jobs First.
