

Controversies: Toray Industries

- In October 2022, [four employees were sent to the hospital due to carbon monoxide poisoning](#) at the Tokai plant of DuPont-Toray.
- In July 2022, Toray Building Materials revealed that [their construction materials were inappropriately certified as flame retardant](#) by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport, and Tourism which didn't meet the requirements.
- In March 2022, it was revealed that Toray had been [illegally gaining global safety certificates](#) (UL certification) for its 52 resin products for more than 10 years.
- In February 2021, a [fire](#) occurred at the Aichi plant, which burned down a storehouse (no casualties).
- According to the company's [CSR report for 2018](#), there was one incident of chemical liquids leaking out of its factory into the environment, polluting the water. Toray Industries states that it caused minuscule environmental damage.
- Between 2018 and 2022, Toray and its subsidiaries [were not fined for any environmental violations](#), according to the violation tracker project of Good Jobs First.
