

## Controversies: PTT Global Chemical

- In January 2023, it was shown that [PTT-owned Allnex failed to report a chemical spill](#) at one of its facilities in December 2022 despite an [odour complaint](#) having been made by a neighbouring residence.
- In 2023, the [PTT group was ranked 35 in the Toxic 100 Water Polluters Index Report 2023](#). The report was prepared based on 2021 public emissions data by the Political Economy Research Institute at the University of Massachusetts, Amherst.
- In 2023, a report by the Minderoo Foundation put PTT on the list of [the top 20 plastics manufacturers](#) responsible for more than half of the single-use plastics polluting the environment.
- In October 2022, PTT-owned Allnex New Zealand Ltd. was fined [\\$112,000](#) for spilling 8000 litres of methyl methacrylate (MMA) into a stormwater drain leading out to the Manukau Harbour in February 2021, which killed more than 100 eels.
- In July 2022, there was a [chemical spill](#) at the Allnex (now PTT-owned) chemical plant on Missouri Avenue. This made the City of East St. Louis advise nearby residents to stay at home and others to avoid the area, as the chemicals spilt were harmful.
- On July 10, 2022, [two men were injured in a chemical explosion](#) at PTT-owned Allnex USA, a resins factory in East St. Louis, Illinois.
- In May 2022, a report presented at a regular meeting of the Louisville Metro Air Pollution Control Board [reported a PPT-owned Allnex sewer contamination on March 11, 2022](#). An [odour complaint](#) had been made by multiple neighbouring residences.
- In April 2022, the Indonesian government planned to launch domestic and legal action against PTT for recovery of environmental and economic losses arising from a [2009 Montara oil spill offshore Australia](#).
- In April 2022, a month after a [styrene spill](#) from PTT-owned Allnex's St Louis, Illinois, facility, neighbours continued to complain of foul odours. This is the third such complaint by residents since 2020, according to the city's Air Pollution District.
- In December 2021, PTT's upcycling programs came under criticism for [misleading consumers into believing that the corporation is engaging productively with the plastics crisis](#), while the company's production far outweighs any impact of its collect-and-upcycle programs.
- PTT Global Chemical is not listed in the violation tracker project of Good Jobs First.
